**Swimming Pool Rules 2005**



**POOL HOURS: Monday-Friday 6:00a.m. -10:00p.m**  
**Saturday, Sunday and Holidays 8:00 a.m. -10:00 p.m.**

The following rules are from the \*Oregon's Department of Human Services - Health Division\* and the MVV HOA. They are for the safety and enjoyment of all residents.

The **pool area** is defined as the court within the fence surrounding the pool; the **picnic area** is located east of the pool on the old concrete.

- 1) **Sign in** when entering the pool area.
- 2) Use of the pool and picnic areas is confined to **residents and members of their families living with them and houseguests accompanied at all times by the adult resident.** Limit guests to four when pool area is busy.
- 3) \* Bathers shall take a **cleansing shower** before entering the pool.
- 4) \* No person shall swim alone.
- 5) \* Non-swimmers and children under 14 years of age shall not use the pool unless a responsible adult observer (resident) is present.
- 6) \* The **lifeline shall be in place at all times.** Exception - when pool use is restricted to lap swimming by competent swimmers only (two or more or one with an observer and **no others** bathers). **No hanging or playing on the lifeline.**
- 7) \* No person suffering from a communicable disease, wearing a band-aid, or under the influence of an intoxicating liquor or drug shall use the pool.
- 8) Individuals not toilet trained must wear plastic pants in the pool.
- 9) **NO OBSCENE, LOUD OR DISRESPECTFUL LANGUAGE OR BEHAVIOR.**
- 10) \* **No person shall run or engage in horseplay** anywhere within the pool area including cannonballs, hitting & dunking.
- 11) The following are **NOT** allowed in the pool area:
  - \*Food, gum or drink (see exception below)
  - Alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs
  - \*Glass products
  - Frisbees, balls
  - Pets
  - Skates, bicycles, skateboards, etc.
  - Styrofoam floating devices
  - Rubber rafts, inner tubes
  - Street clothes – swimming attire onlyThe following **ARE** allowed if they DO NOT interfere with others' use of the pool or result in horseplay or other unsafe conditions:
  - Floatation devices for small children
  - Snorkeling equipment
  - Air mattresses (if space permits)
  - Noodles
  - Lightweight diving toys
  - Radios/boom boxes with earphones or low volume (None IN the pool)
- 12) \* No person shall bring, throw or carry food, gum, drink, smoking material, trash, debris or any other foreign substances into the pool.
